## What is Geometry?

The fundamental purpose of this course is to formalize and extend students' geometric experiences from middle school. Students explore more complex geometric situations and deepen their explanations of geometric relationships, moving towards formal mathematical arguments (proofs). Transformations and constructions are emphasized early in this course. The Mathematical Practice Standards will be applied throughout the course and, together with the Content Standards, students will experience mathematics as a coherent, useful and logical subject that makes use of their ability to make sense of real world situations.


Students wishing to pursue an Advanced Regents Diploma must pass the Geometry and Algebra II Regents Examinations.
